

59 "One Another" Passages to Help Grow Your Sexual Intimacy

1. Mark 9:50, "Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt among yourselves, and be at peace with each other."

Have salt in yourselves - Have the preserving, purifying principle always; the principles of denying yourselves, of suppressing pride, ambition, contention, etc., and thus you will be an acceptable offering to God (from Barnes' Notes on the Bible).

Have peace - Avoid contention and quarreling, struggling for places, honors, and office, and seek each other's welfare, and religion will be honored and preserved in the world (from Barnes' Notes on the Bible).

2. John 13:14, "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet."

3&4. John 13:34, "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another."

5. John 13:35, "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

6. John 15:12, "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you."

7. John 15:17, "This is my command: Love each other."

8. Romans 12:10, "Be devoted to one another in love..."

9. Romans 12:10, "Honor one another above yourselves."

10. Romans 12:16, "Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited."

11. Romans 13:8, "Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law."

12. Romans 14:13, "Therefore, let us stop passing judgment on one another, instead make your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister."

13. Romans 15:7, "Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God."

14. Romans 15:14, "I myself am convinced, my brothers and sisters, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with knowledge, and competence to instruct one another."

15. Romans 16:16, "Greet one another with a holy kiss."

16. 1 Corinthians 11:33, "So then, my brothers and sisters, when you gather to eat, you should all eat together."

17. 1 Corinthians 12:25, "...so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other."

18. 1 Corinthians 16:20, "All the brothers and sisters here send you greetings. Greet one another with a holy kiss."

19. 2 Corinthians 13:12, "Greet one another with a holy kiss."
20. Galatians 5:13, "You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge in the flesh [sinful acts, not healthy marital intimacy]; rather, serve one another humbly in love."
21. Galatians 5:15, "If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other."
22. Galatians 5:26, "Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other."
23. Galatians 6:2, "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."
24. Ephesians 4:2, "Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love."
- 25&26. Ephesians 4:32, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ."
27. Ephesians 5:19, "...speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord."
28. Ephesians 5:21, "Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ."
29. Philippians 2:3-4, "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of others."
30. Colossians 3:9, "Do not lie to each other since you have taken off your old self with its practices."
- 31&32. Colossians 3:13, "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against anyone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you."
- 33&34. Colossians 3:16, "Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts."
35. 1 Thessalonians 3:12, "May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you."
36. 1 Thessalonians 4:9, "Now about your love for one another, we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other."
37. 1 Thessalonians 4:18, "Therefore, encourage one another with these words."
- 38&39. 1 Thessalonians 5:11, "Therefore, encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing."

40. Hebrews 3:13, "But, encourage one another daily as long as it is called "Today," so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness."
41. Hebrews 10:24, "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds."
42. Hebrews 10:25, "...not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day approaching."
43. James 4:11, "Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another..."
44. James 5:9, "Don't grumble against one another, brothers and sister..."
45. James 5:16, "Therefore, confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed..."
- 47&48. 1 Peter 3:8, "Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble."
49. 1 Peter 4:8, "Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins."
50. 1 Peter 4:9, "Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling."
51. 1 Peter 4:10, "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms."
52. 1 Peter 5:5, "In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders. All of you clothe yourselves in humility toward one another, because, 'God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble.'"
53. 1 Peter 5:14, "Greet one another with a kiss of love."
54. 1 John 3:11, "For this is the message you heard from the beginning: We should love one another."
55. 1 John 3:23, "And this is his command: to believe in the name of his son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us."
56. 1 John 4:7, "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God."
57. 1 John 4:11, "Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."
58. 1 John 4:12, "No one has ever seen God: but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us."
59. 2 John 5, "And now, dear lady, I am not writing you a new command but one we have had from the beginning. I ask that we love one another."
